

Bali Process Training Curriculum for Information Sharing to Address People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime

The training curriculum promotes a coordinated approach to information sharing among Bali Process Members, in line with the shared commitment to enhancing information sharing to address the challenges of people smuggling, trafficking in persons and related transnational crime.

The curriculum has been developed by the Regional Support Office (RSO) of the Bali Process and draws on the *Bali Process Framework for Information Sharing* and the *Bali Process Guidelines for Information Sharing to Address People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime*.

The curriculum covers practices, principles and processes for effective and successful cross-border information sharing. Topics covered include how information is used, requesting information, making information valuable to the recipient and providing information in a manner that satisfies relevant security, ethical and legal considerations.

The curriculum is suitable for a broad audience and has been designed in flexible modules so that it can be tailored for training audience needs, including different training time periods and experience levels.

The training curriculum consists of:

- Facilitator's Guide
- Student Handbook for participant note taking and important handouts
- Training materials, including a slide deck, handouts, exercise and scenario instructions.

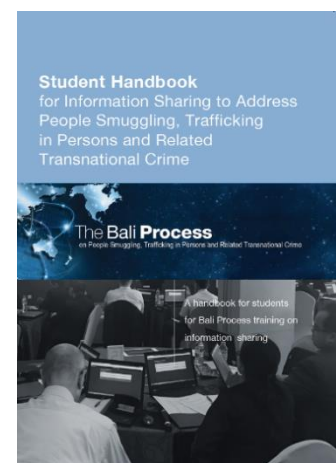


The **Facilitator's Guide** is designed to assist in the delivery of training. It includes:
